Ladies to invite men to the sorting. It must be a lady and a man or youth or master. Either way there must be 1 lady on the team. The class starts as all sorting classes start however at some point at riders choosing the team must re-sort the cattle, they have already sorted back the other way in reverse order. No cattle are counted as sorted until they return across the centerline from the reverse direction. Eg the team is given number 3, they sort 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 in about 30 seconds. Then they go get the 8 and sort it back across the foul line and it is counted as the 1st cow sorted at 35 seconds. Then they get the 7, 6 and 5 before the time expires. Their final time was 4 cows sorted (both ways) in 59.2 secs.
